- ii) All the trainee Civil Judges (Junior Division), shall maintain a daily diary with regard to the practical training and submit a report at the end of each day to the in charge District Judge nominated, for scrutiny.

Instructions to all the Unit Heads:

- i) All the Unit Heads are requested to permit the trainee Civil Judges (Junior Division) to attend the practical training from **06.04.2026 to 02.05.2026** at their respective District Headquarters and give necessary instructions, as per the schedule.
- ii) At the end of training period, the Unit Heads shall submit a report to the High Court with regard to the training undergone by the officers and copy of the same to the APJA, Mangalagiri.
- iii) All the Unit Heads are requested to instruct the officers, who are holding full additional charge of the posts of the trainee Civil Judges

(Junior Division) to draw, pay and allowances of the officers during training period and send the same to the Officers.

- iv) All the Unit Heads are requested to monitor the overall practical training programme.
- v) All the Unit Heads are requested to nominate a senior District Judge as in-charge of the training programme.
- vi) All the Unit Heads are requested to provide a suitable lunch room to the trainee Civil Judges (Junior Division).
- vii) All the **trainee Civil Judges (Junior Division)**, may be allowed to sit along with the regular presiding officer of the Judicial Magistrate of First Class/Civil Judges (Junior Division) Courts
- viii) All the Unit Heads are requested to interact with the trainee Civil Judges (Junior Division) once in a week and observe the notes prepared by them and to guide suitably.
- ix) After completion of training period, the Unit Heads shall submit a comprehensive report about each trainee Civil Judge (Junior Division) to the High Court and the Director, APJA, Mangalagiri.
