NOTIFICATION FOR FILLING UP OF SIXTEEN (16) VACANCIES OF CIVIL JUDGE (SENIOR DIVISION) BY ACCELERATED PROMOTION THROUGH A LIMITED DEPARTMENTAL COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION (LDCE) FROM THE CATEGORY OF CIVIL JUDGE (JUNIOR DIVISION) WHO HAVE PUT IN NOT LESS THAN THREE YEARS SERVICE AS CIVIL JUDGE (JUNIOR DIVISION) BY THE END OF 31ST MARCH, 2026 IN THE A.P. STATE JUDICIAL SERVICE.

Applications are invited to fill up sixteen (16) vacancies of Civil Judge (Senior Division) by Accelerated promotion through a Limited Departmental Competitive Examination (LDCE) from the category of Civil Judge (Junior Division) who have put in not less than three years service as Civil Judge (Junior Division) by the end of 31st March, 2026 in the Andhra Pradesh State Judicial Service. The scale of pay for the post of Civil Judge (Senior Division) is Rs.111000 – 163030.

Note:

The High Court of Andhra Pradesh reserves the right to increase or decrease the number of vacancies or cancel the Notification, at any stage, without assigning any reason whatsoever. No right will accrue to the candidate by virtue of the Notification.

The Andhra Pradesh State Judicial (Service and Cadre) Rules, 2026 shall be applicable to the recruitment process.

All necessary steps not provided under these rules for recruitment, shall be decided by the High Court.

I (i). QUALIFICATIONS:

A person to be appointed to the category of Civil Judge (Senior Division) by Accelerated Promotion through a Limited Departmental Competitive Examination (LDCE) shall be:

(a) One who have put in not less than 3 years of service as Civil Judge (Junior Division) by the end of 31st March, 2026 in the Andhra Pradesh State Judicial Service.

(ii) DISQUALIFICATIONS:

(a) Any officer in the cadre of Civil Judge (Junior Division) facing disciplinary charges or is undergoing punishment for any irregularity in discharge of his/her duties shall not be eligible for appointment by promotion through a Limited Departmental Competitive Examination to the post of Civil Judge (Senior Division).

(b) Any Officer having found to be of doubtful integrity in any year, shall not be eligible to appear for the post of Civil Judge (Senior Division) through a Limited Departmental Competitive Examination.

II. RESERVATION :

The vertical reservations in respect of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes as per the A.P. State Judicial (Service & Cadre) Rules, 2026 read with amended Rule 22 and 22-A of the A.P. State and Subordinate Service Rules issued vide G.O.Ms.No.77, General Administration (Services-D) Department, dated 02.08.2023 and G.O.Ms.No.46, General Administration (Services-D) Department, dated 19.04.2025 is applicable.

III. DOCUMENTS TO BE ENCLOSED FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

1. The candidates shall enclose attested copy of certificate evidencing date of Birth/SSC, Law Degree and other certificates.
2. The candidate shall enclose attested copy of community certificate issued by the Competent Authority, if intend to avail reservation under SC and ST category (the certificate shall show specifically the classification of the group).
3. Service Certificate in the Cadre of Civil Judge (Junior Division) issued by the Competent Authority.
4. The candidate shall produce all original certificates on the day of *Viva Voce* for verification. If the candidate fails to produce any of the required certificate, his/her candidature will be rejected, without any further correspondence.

IV. SCHEME OF EXAMINATION:

The process of selection is as follows:-

- a) For the purpose of short-listing the candidates, if any, the High Court will conduct Computer based Screening Test for 100 marks comprising of 100 multiple choice objective type questions. The duration of examination will be two (2) hours. The Venue and Time will be mentioned in the Hall Ticket, to be downloaded by the candidate at an appropriate point of time.

The candidate who secure 40% and above marks in the screening test will be short listed in the ratio of 1:10 of the available vacancies, for the written examination.

Provided that, if there is more than one candidate who have secured identical marks in the screening test in particular category, all such candidates shall be called for the written examination.

The marks obtained in the screening test shall not be added to the marks obtained in the written examination and they shall not be counted for determining final order of merit in selection of the candidates, as the screening test is conducted only for the purpose of short-listing the candidates.

Note: Conduct of Screening Test will depend on the number of applications received from the aspiring candidates.

- b) Written Examination consist of the following three (3) papers. Each paper will carry 100 marks. The duration of each paper is three (3) hours.

The question/s in the examination shall be answered only in English (except Translation)

Paper-I- Civil Laws

Paper-II - Criminal Laws

Paper-III- English (Translation and Essay writing).

Paper-III English (Translation and Essay Writing) is divided into two parts. Part-I carries 40 marks and Part-II carries 60 marks. In Part-I the candidate is required to translate a passage from English to Telugu and from Telugu to English. In Part-II, candidate's ability in Essay writing is tested. The Essay writing test shall be on Legal Subjects only.

The candidates shall secure 40% of marks in each Part in Paper-III English (Translation and Essay writing test) and the marks secured in Paper-III shall not be taken into account for eligibility for viva voce or selection. The marks secured in Paper-I, Paper-II and viva voce shall be taken into account for selection.

**V. MINIMUM MARKS TO BE SECURED IN WRITTEN EXAMINATION TO
TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR *VIVA VOCE*:**

The candidates, shall secure not less than 55% of marks in Paper-I and Paper-II and not less than 60% of marks in aggregate in written examination.

VI. *VIVA VOCE*:

The *Viva Voce* test is for 50 marks.

The successful candidates in written examination will be called for *Viva Voce* in the ratio of 1:3 of the available vacancies, and if there is more than one candidate who have secured identical cut off marks, all such candidates shall be called upon to appear for *Viva Voce*.

Any candidate who remain absent for the *Viva Voce* will be deemed to have been disqualified for selection.

No TA and DA will be paid to the candidates appearing for Screening Test (if any)/Written Examination/*Viva Voce*.

The decision of High Court as to the eligibility or otherwise of a candidate for admission to Screening test (if any), written examination and *Viva Voce* shall be final. Only candidates who are issued with Hall Tickets shall be admitted for the examination.

**VII. MINIMUM AGGREGATE MARKS TO BE SECURED IN THE WRITTEN
EXAMINATION AND *VIVA VOCE* FOR SELECTION TO THE POST OF CIVIL
JUDGE (SENIOR DIVISION) (LDCE):**

For the selection to the posts of Civil Judge (Senior Division) under Accelerated Promotion through a Limited Departmental Competitive Examination, the candidates shall secure at least 60% marks in aggregate in Written Examination and *Viva Voce*. The candidates who secure less than such percentage of marks will be ineligible for selection to the post.

Provided that if two or more candidates secure equal marks in the written examination and *Viva voce*, the elder in age will be considered for provisional selection. In case of a tie in age also, the candidate, who possesses higher educational qualification would be considered. In case of tie in higher educational qualification also, the candidate with highest marks in the prescribed educational qualification will be considered.

The application (*pro forma* appended) along with the necessary enclosures including hall ticket-cum-identity card (original and duplicate), Service Certificate in the cadre of Civil Judge (Junior Division), appointment order of Civil Judge (Junior Division) and caste certificate in respect of S.C. and S.T. candidates shall be submitted in the office of the Principal District Judge concerned not later than 5.00 P.M. on 01.10.2026.

Applications received after the last date will be summarily rejected.
